Type of Activity: Erasmus+ Training Course

Aim: This training aims to exchange knowledge and experience in working with youth with disabilities and international mobility projects. Understand the inclusion strategy of the European Union. Explore ways to maximise support for organisations and young people in youth exchanges and European Solidarity Corps volunteering opportunities.

Venue: Pécs, Hungary

Accommodation: Zsolnay Vendégház (in two-bed apartments).

Dates: 11 (arrival day)-18 (departure day) May 2025

Food: Three meals per day. Two snacks provided daily. Dietary preferences or restrictions will be accommodated upon request.

Participating Countries: Spain, Italy, Romania, Croatia, Hungary

Participants: Three participants per country (aged 18+). Individuals working with people with disabilities or in international youth mobility programs.

Weather in May In Pécs: May typically brings mild and pleasant weather: Average daytime temperature: 18–24°C. Occasional rain showers, so packing a light jacket or umbrella is recommended.

Currency and Prices:

Currency: Hungarian Forint (HUF). Approximate exchange rate: 1 EUR \approx 380-400 HUF (subject to fluctuations). Example prices: Coffee: 500-800 HUF Meal at a restaurant: 2,500-4,500 HUF Public transport ticket: 400 HUF

How to Get to Pécs Arrive in Hungary: The nearest international airport is Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport (BUD).

Travel to Pécs: By train: Direct trains run from Budapest's Keleti Railway Station to Pécs (approx. 2.5–3 hours). By bus: Buses from Budapest to Pécs are also available.
